GRAND FINALS SUCCESS FOR STAGS' TEAMS

Hemel Stags Community teams enjoyed success in their respective grand finals recently.

The Stags open age side retained their East Region Premier Division title with a convincing 36-10 win over rivals Bedford Tigers in a stirring encounter at Pennine Way on 19 August

Late July saw the culmination of the London and South East Junior League programme.

All of the Stags junior team made the semi finals but pride of place went to the Under 13's—coached by Dan Stocks and Gareth Swindells—who went all the way to win the Grand Final 30-4 against local rivals St Albans Centurions .

This was the first grand final win for the Stags at Junior League level since 2008 when the club won the U16's title with a team that contained the likes Dan Sargison and Jamie Acton.

The club's Under 14's—coached by Luke Ashton & Shane Hurley—went through the regular season undefeated only to miss out on a grand final place with a narrow two point loss in the semi final

Similarly, the Under 16's—coached by Harrison Brough and Mike Stewart—topped the table at the end of the regular season but unfortunately crashed out in the semi final.

Kendra wanted a photo with the Hemel players and she found a place in the lads hearts and they were captivated by her love of Rugby League and the fact that she never stopped smiling.

When the Hemel players found out that a campaign

existed to try and raise some money to help make Kendra's house more accessible for her they got together and decided they would like to help. Every player has donated the same amount of money to the pot and the money that had been collected over the season from indiscretions determined by the "player's court" has been given to the fund instead of its original purpose of funding the players' end of season party!
